

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) BBA

1.	Why should I apply for IMU's BBA 2025?
	Candidates who are desirous of joining the BBA (Logistics, Retailing and e-Commerce) Programme / Apprenticeship embedded BBA (Maritime Logistics) Programme, are required to register through the link provided in IMU's website. The admission to the BBA programmes will be done through a suitable mechanism which will be intimated in due course of time.
2.	What are the timeline for IMU's BBA 2025?
	Will be intimated in due course on website. Please visit https://www.imu.edu.in/
3.	How can I apply for IMU's BBA?
	Candidates can apply on the basis of 12th grade scores. The link for registration is available in IMU website.
4.	Whether the Entrance Test will be conducted for BBA ?
	Admission to BBA will be on merit basis based on the aggregate of 12th standard marks.
5.	Can the dates of Publication of Selected Candidates/Counselling etc. change?
	Yes, due to administrative reasons, the dates can change. Hence the candidates are advised to keep visiting the website regularly for updates.
6.	Is there any age relaxation/concession for OBC(NCL)/SC/ST/Female Category Students?
	Relaxation of Maximum age: For Male: OBC(NCL)-3 years, SC/ST-5 years For Female: General-2 years, OBC (NCL)-5 years, SC/ST-7 years. The reference date for calculation of the age will be from the date of commencement of the Academic Session (01.08.2025) For SC/ST Candidates there will be a 5% relaxation in eligibility marks in Aggregate Percentage; however, it will not apply to English Marks.

7.	I forgot my Password for Login; is there any way to recover the same?
	Yes. Below Registration Form there is a link “Forgot password/User ID”. Kindly fill the same, your User ID/ Password will be sent to registered email id at the time of basic registration.
8.	I have completed my SSLC in CBSE board and my results are in CGPA pattern; the fields in Academic Portion in Application Form are in Percentage format. How can I convert CGPA to percentage in order to complete the Online Application?
	Multiply the Grade Point by 9.5 in order to get the equivalent percentage marks.
9.	I have appeared for +2 Board Exam in 2025 and my results are not yet declared, How I can complete “Academic Details” in Online Application Form?
	Candidate has to choose ‘Result awaited’ option; however he/she has to fill the Roll No, School Board details etc.
10	I have completed +2 in distance mode through NIOS/BOSSE. Whether am I eligible for admissions to BBA?
	Yes. However students who have completed through the School Boards which are classified as fake Board by Ministry of Education are in-eligible for admissions to IMU.
11.	Whether rounding off of the percentage of marks for English, etc are allowed, while filling up of the online application?
	No. Rounding off is not permitted.
12.	I made a mistake in name/ DOB/wrong marks while filling the application form and I had successfully submitted the application. Is there any way to correct the mistake?
	Once application form is successfully submitted, there is no way to correct the same. In such case, candidate has to apply afresh with new email id and mobile number.

13.	How do I know I have submitted the application successfully?
	The Detailed Application form consists of four portions, namely- Personal Details, Academic Details. Documents Upload and Payment Details. Candidate has to complete all these portions. Once the payment is successful, candidate Dash Board will appear, from which he/she can download the filled-in application.
14.	I have applied for UG (BTech, BSc, DNS) Programme. Whether I am automatically eligible for BBA Programme?
	No. Candidate has to apply separately for UG (BTech, BSc, DNS) Programme and BBA Programme (for which no CET) with requisite fees, if they desire to apply for both.
15.	Is it mandatory to submit the hard copy of filled-in application to IMU?
	No. Candidate can download the filled in application for reference and record and it is not necessary to submit the same to IMU.
16.	What is Apprenticeship Embedded BBA(ML) programme?
	All BBA Maritime Logistics students are provided with apprenticeship. The student-apprentice may get monthly stipend during the apprenticeship period as per the provisions of Apprentices Act, 1961 under NAPS, which is a minimum of Rs.7, 000.
17.	What is the duration of Apprenticeship?
	BBA (Maritime Logistics) is a 3 years programme and the apprenticeship will be during the 3rd year.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) Foreign Direct Admission

1.	Who is a "Foreign National"?
	<p>A candidate is considered as a "Foreign National" who</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Holds a passport/ Citizenship of a country other than India. OR • Has an OCI/ PIO card and also holds a Passport of a country other than India. <p>Note:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • An applicant having an OCI card and studying throughout in India will be considered as a "Foreign National". • Non-Resident Indian (NRI) / Indian Citizen whose qualifying examination is from an International Board/ Foreign University will NOT BE CONSIDERED as Foreign National.
2.	How can a Foreign National applicant get admission to any programme (Diploma /UG/PG) in the Indian Maritime University?
	<p>The detailed information regarding the admission of foreign nationals at Indian Maritime University for the academic year 2025 - 2026 are available on IMU's website. Interested applicants shall apply through the online application form available at: https://www.imu.edu.in</p> <p>Note: There is no off-line application form.</p>
3.	When does the process of foreign admission begin at Indian Maritime University (IMU)?
	<p>The admission process for IMU in UG/PG Programmes for foreign nationals usually starts in the month of March/April.</p>
4.	Is there any authorized agency or organization for forwarding the application for admission to Indian Maritime University?
	<p>There is no private agency for forwarding the applications for admission. A candidate can apply in multiple programmes/courses by choosing all the programmes/courses in which you wish to apply through a single online registration form.</p>
5.	Is there any entrance examination conducted by Indian Maritime University to get admission in Diploma/UG/PG Programmes for foreign nationals?
	<p>Foreign national applicants are exempted from Entrance exams for admission in Diploma/UG programmes. The admission of foreign nationals at Indian Maritime University shall be made on the basis of the merit/performance in the qualifying examinations, subject to the fulfilment of the eligibility requirement for the said programme and the availability of seats. The entrance examination requirement is indicated below:</p>

	Sl.No.	Programme	Entrance Test
	1.	UG (B.Tech. & B.Sc.) Programmes	Applicant should have an equivalent 12th grade qualification or a valid JEE (Main) rank. Preference will be given to candidates with a JEE (Mains) rank if the number of applicants exceeds the number of seats available for foreign admissions.
	2.	UG (BBA) Programmes	No entrance test required; applicants must have an equivalent 12th grade qualification.
	3.	PG (M.Tech) Programmes	Applicants must have a valid GRE (Revised General Test) Score of at least 300.
	4.	PG (MBA) Programmes	Applicants must have a valid GMAT score of at least 480.
6.	How much fee is payable by a foreign national student?		
	The foreign national student's tuition fee is same as that of an Indian Student. Fee details are provided in the Prospectus.		
7.	What type of visa is required for admission to various programmes in IMU?		
	<p>The following types of visa is required for admission to various degree programmes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Student Visa for all/UG/PG Programmes • Research Visa for Ph.D programmes. <p>The visa must be endorsed in the name of the Indian Maritime University. No other endorsement will be acceptable.</p>		
8.	What is the period of semesters and vacations?		
	The details of Semesters and vacations are provided in the academic calendar approved by the university for each academic year. For reference, Academic Calendar for Under-Graduate and Post-Graduate courses for the Academic Year 2024-2025 is available at IMU website.		
9.	Am I required to register with any office after arrival in India? If so, what is the time duration?		
	It is mandatory that you register with the Foreigner Regional Registration Office (FRRO) within 14 days of arrival.
